

#### ANU Union Electoral Regulations:

(1) These regulations are solely for the interpretation of s26(14) of the Constitution of the Australian National University Union Incorporated. They are enacted under s26(14)(d).

(2) The receipts and expenditures lodged with the Returning Officer must be attached to a signed statement of expenditure available at the Union Office upon request.

(3) The convenor of each ticket shall lodge the statements of expenditure with the ANU Union Office which shall then disseminate these statements to the Returning Officer.

(4) The statement of expenditure must be lodged with the Union Office by the opening of polls each day.

(5) The calculation of a ticket or independent candidate's expenditure shall include all financial and non-financial (in kind) contributions to that ticket or independent candidate's campaign.

(6) Non-financial (in kind) contributions shall be calculated at market value by the electoral arbiter and include, but are not limited to, printing facilities, paper, sticky tape, chalk, glue and other sundry items.

(7) The following items shall be exempt from calculating a ticket or independent candidate's expenditure:

- a. T-shirts
- b. Tables
- c. Chairs
- d. Marquee
- e. Any other item that, in the electoral arbiter's view, would be impractical to include as they are of capital nature.
